

C&C Constructions to diversify into power

Mumbai: Infrastructure development firm C&C Constructions plans to diversify into construction of power transmission towers as a part of its future growth plan. The company is a major player in road-building and water pipelines with over Rs 2,100 crore worth of projects under execution at present. "Building power transmission towers will be another vertical in the infrastructure segment for us. It is a high-growth segment and we have big plans here," C&C Constructions Chairman G S Johar said.
